Students will...

1. Create an Evernote account using their academic emails and password.
2. Download Evernote to their computers/ laptops/ iPads.
3. Access Evernote across multiple platforms using their created account.
4. Set up notebooks for each subject area and share with teachers.
5. Create notes with text, images, and voice recording.
6. Organize notes through the use of tags and note info.
7. Share notes via email, twitter, etc...
